

2019 Waukesha Education Foundation, Inc. Grant Report

The Waukesha Education Foundation, Inc. reviewed a record number of grant applications submitted this year by educators in the School District of Waukesha, with over \$159,000+ in requests within 95 applications. The Grant Selection Committee selected applications that met the criteria set forth by WEF's mission and restrictions within the available funds. Thirty-three (33) applications were selected, totaling just over \$35,000 in grants.
