



Consent for Treatment FAQ's

Q: Why am I signing this consent form?

A: This consent for treatment form means you are giving permission for the Children's Wisconsin licensed athletic trainer at your child's school to provide medical care for sports related injuries.

Q: What does "other providers" mean in the first statement?

A: A provider is a member of Children's Wisconsin's medical staff. Licensed athletic trainers are included in our definition of "other providers."

Q: Will I be billed for treatment provided by a Children's licensed athletic trainer while my child is at school?

A: Treatment provided by a Children's licensed athletic trainer during regularly scheduled training hours, at practices and at games are provided at no charge.

Q: When would I be billed by Children's Wisconsin?

A: If further care is needed beyond licensed athletic training services, your child may be referred to see an orthopedic or sports medicine specialist at Children's Wisconsin. If an appointment and/or diagnostic testing is required, charges would apply to these services. We recommend checking with your health insurance prior to being treated to confirm your insurance coverage.
