Literacy Lane:



Besides reading our own names and our friends' names, we have now had practice reading color words and kindergarten sight words.

We have been reading and making books that have patterned text as well. These predictable reads are helping us use our reading finger and develop "voice print match." (Pointing/reading the actual word we are saying)

We will be continuing to work on increasing our reading stamina as we delve deeper into reader's workshop. Be on the look-out for Literacy Bags to come home VERY soon!

Writer's workshop: We continue to s-t-r-e-t-c-h out words to sound spell, particularly beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words. Students have been working on adding setting and character feelings into their stories. We are now working on writing a story with a beginning, middle, and end.

Math:

- 2D shapes (identifying/naming/analyzing)
- Sorting objects (by size, color, shape, other attributes)
- Counting sets of objects and representing with the correct numeral (one-to-one correspondence & numeral writing 0-20)
- Positional words (up, under, over, around, between, etc.)
- Addition and subtraction using objects
