Math:

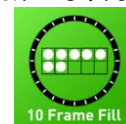
Key concepts:



- use a variety of strategies to solve math problems (acting it out, using objects, drawing pictures)
- practice writing addition and subtraction equations (number sentences)
- using math vocabulary (greater/less, plus, minus, equal)
- discuss measurable attributes of objects (length, height, weight, etc.)
- writing numerals 0-20 (no reversals)
