

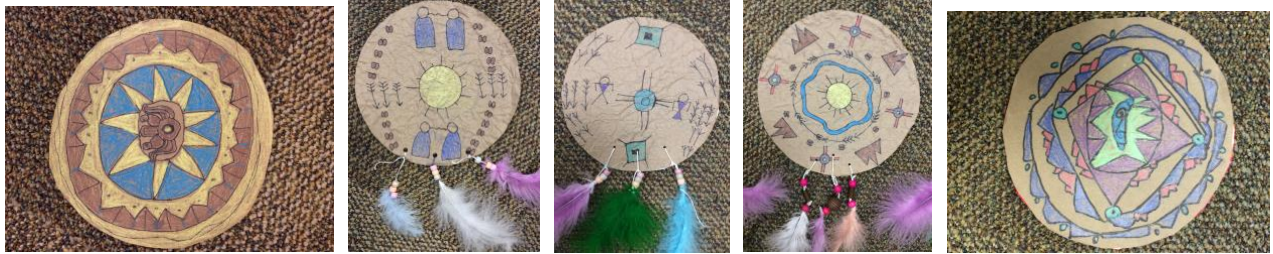
Art Newsletter

The art room has been a busy place this past month. Students have been learning about art from different cultures and creating art inspired by various habitats.

Fifth graders have been learning about Native American and South American tribes in Social Studies. They have also been learning about how artwork can be a form of communication. The final product resulted in the creation of Native American shields and ancient stones carvings.



Fourth grade learned some chinese watercolor techniques and created several small pieces that folded into origami lanterns. Part of their requirement was to use traditional imagery and symbols.
