

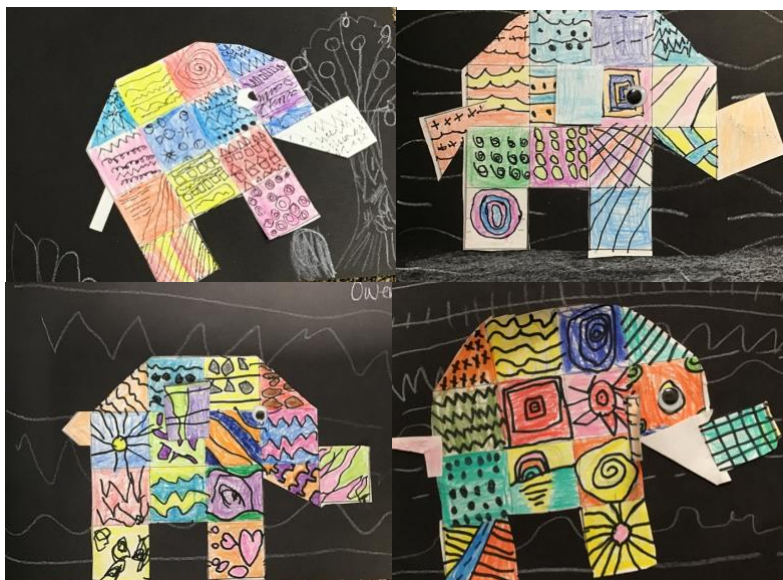
Art Newsletter

We have been busy creating in the classroom! Check out some of the awesome art different grade levels have been working on!

Kindergarten practiced cutting out shapes, writing alphabet letters, and experimenting with water and marker for the background of their art piece.



In first grade we read Elmer's Special Day, by David McKee and Elisabeth Duval. Students practiced their pattern making and folded their papers into elephants.



It's that time of year again where second graders learn about Vincent Van Gogh's artwork. They learned how Van Gogh used various lines to show movement in his artwork and layered colors. Students use oil pastels and water color to explore the combination of Van Gogh's sunflowers and *Starry Night* paintings.



Fourth grade learned about artist M.C Escher and created their own tessellations.
