LITERACY:

Reading: I am SO EXCITED to see how each student has grown as a reader! Everyone is using voice print match, using their picture clues and looking at the beginning sound of a word to figure out an unknown word! We've now moved on to the "skip it and come back to it" strategy!

Writer's workshop: We continue to s-t-r-e-t-c-h out words to sound spell, particularly beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words. I am so proud of the progress I've seen in writing so far!
