LITERACY:

Reading workshop is in full swing and I've seen SO MUCH progress and growth. By now, the kids have learned many more sight words and many are incorporating a variety of strategies to read leveled text!

We've been working on a variety of letters and their sounds in phonics workshop.

Writer's workshop: We continue to s-t-r-e-t-c-h out words to sound spell, particularly beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words. Some friends are even writing on the front AND the back of their writing pieces!



Reminder: You are encouraged to send a **healthy** snack to school with your child each day. Your child may also bring a reusable bottle with water to keep on hand.

With the weather getting colder PLEASE send your child dressed appropriately to go out to recess. We will be going out twice a day no matter what unless it's raining or below zero.

Math:

- 2D shapes (identifying/naming/analyzing)
- Sorting objects (by size, color, shape, other attributes)
- Counting sets of objects and representing with the correct numeral (one-to-one correspondence & numeral writing 0-20)
- Positional words (up, under, over, around, between, etc.)

We also learned how to use a number track and complete story problems that involve addition and subtraction.
