LITERACY:

Besides reading our own names and our friends' names, we have now had practice reading color words and kindergarten sight words.

We have been reading and making books that have patterned text as well. These predictable reads are helping us use our reading finger and develop "voice print match." (Pointing/reading the actual word we are saying)

We will be continuing to work on increasing our reading stamina as we delve deeper into reader's workshop.

Writer's workshop: We continue to s-t-r-e-t-c-h out words to sound spell, particularly beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words.
