[Binder Sample E](#) (Office Depot)

This binder will support your child's development of organizational skills he/she will need to be successful at Lowell. This binder is intended to last two years; however, wear and tear is dependent on how students take care of it both in and out of school. This binder is also aligned to Lowell's implementation of AVID (Advancement via Individual Determination), which is a system that supports the development of college and career readiness in all learners through a focus on writing, reading, inquiry, organization, and collaboration. One of the major components of AVID Elementary is organization; organization of time, materials, and thought. "A student's ability to self-monitor and self-organize correlates strongly with college and career readiness. Even for the most talented students, however, proficiency in these abilities rarely comes naturally" (AVID Center). Through the implementation of an organized binder system, our goal is to teach all of our learners to how to organize their work, their resources, and their learning tools to maximize their success in school. If your child has a binder from last year that is still in good condition, they may use the same binder more than one year in a row.
